This is to notify you that a written complaint has been received by the Secretary of State, Elections Division, alleging possible violations of Oregon election law. Specifically, the complaint relates to whether the document presented at a February 10, 2009 Town Hall meeting and documents included with the City of Lafayette utility bill violated election law. The Secretary of State, Elections Division, is required to notify any person who may be the subject of such a complaint that the complaint was received. ORS 260.345. The complaint was received on February 11, 2009.
